## REGULATION

1. Citation and commencement
2. Amendment of Schedule to S.I. 130 of 1980

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Works and Communications by section 56 of the Post Office Act, 1980, the following Regulations are hereby made -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Postage and Citation and Miscellaneous Charges) (Amendment) Regulations, 1982, and shall come commenceinto operation on 1st April, 1982.
